



REQUIREMENTS FOR IMPORTING DAIRY AND DAIRY RELATED PRODUCTS

INTO THE KINGDOM OF ESWATINI (In terms of the Dairy Act, 1968 and the Dairy Regulations, 2021)

The requirements include the following:

1. Valid, original and approved EDB application form
2. Valid and Original Eswatini Dairy Board (EDB) permit
3. Valid Export / ZA certificate such as for farm(s) processor(s), distributor(s), transporter(s) and transitor(s)
4. Certificate of product analysis
5. Perishable Product Export Control Board (PPECB) certificate
6. Valid consignment invoices
7. Detailed list and quantities of products to be imported
8. The EDB import permit must be signed by head of the Exporting entity such as head of the processing plant or head of the Distribution centre
9. Name of the processor(s), exporter(s), importer(s), distributor(s) and transporter(s)
10. Intended entry point(s) in Eswatini
11. Detailed protocols on Disease(s) prevention and control/ Risk Analysis plan
 - Overview
 - Protocol at farms
 - Protocol at milk reception
 - Protocol in the process and production facility
 - Protocol for exports
 - Milk and milk products traceability plan (such as milk source(s), seal numbers, batch numbers, product date coding)
 - Protocol for any other area not stated above

The protocols above must include any public health plan; food safety management system; early disease(s) detection, warning, identification, assessment, mitigation, product recall and communication plans.

12. List of milk suppliers (farms and areas) both from FMD disease management areas (DMA) and Disease free areas or Non-DMA. (Please note that milk sourced from DMA is strictly prohibited for export products to Eswatini).
13. Name and contact details of the Veterinary office(s) (Private and State) and Veterinary officer(s) in-charge
14. Where applicable and with EDB's advice, importers may be required to acquire EDB approved permits from other relevant agencies
15. Product recall plan
16. Trade return plan
17. Import Levy
18. Permit fee(s)
